I am attaching a copy of a letter received from Mr. Bague regarding radios for use by the Saskatchewan Fish Board.

Would you kindly contact Mr. Bague the first time you are in the office and discuss this matter with him. I think it would be advisable if you could make available certain radios for their work this winter. It would only be for two or three months during the winter and they could then be returned when finished. I would suggest that you work out a rent basis for radios at so much per month and try and ascertain from Mr. Bague the number of sets they will be using throughout the year. You can keep in mind the service we would provide from our main bases in this regard too. I would suggest a flat rate for the use of each set which would include services over our regular network. After you have seen Mr. Bague I would like to discuss it further with you.
